# Why Do You Reed Advising?

You have chosen one of the most challenging majors on any college campus, and we want to ensure you are taking your classes in the correct order so you can graduate on time!

- Important Pre-requisites

And your Academic Advisor is the expert on course sequencing for your major!



## Important steps to Register

Before you can register for Baylor courses...

- You must be advised by your Academic Advisor
  - Your Academic Advisor will send you information about how to schedule your advising appointment on <u>Navigate</u>
- You must resolve any Registration Holds on your account



Before you can register for Baylor courses, you must clear any Registrations Holds on your account.

The next few slides provide information on Common Registration Holds and what steps you need to take to remove these Holds



#### **Health Services Hold**

- Complete and submit your <u>Health Form</u> to the Baylor Health Center
- Submit your <u>Meningitis Vaccination records</u>

#### **Census Hold**

You will need to provide additional information on your Bearweb account

- 1. Go to <a href="https://www.baylor.edu/bearweb">www.baylor.edu/bearweb</a> to Log in to Bearweb
- 2. Click on "Personal Information," then "Update Census Data"
- 3. Select your "Religion" and "Update Information"

### Tronsfer Credit

Ensure you have sent any transfer credit to Baylor

- <u>College Credit</u> Official Transcript should be sent from each institution where you've earned credit
- <u>Credit by Exam</u> (AP, IB, SAT II, CLEP) Scores must be sent separate from your college transcript
- Please review the <u>Transfer Course Recommendations</u> if you plan to take any classes before starting classes at Baylor



### Plocement Exoms

Some Baylor courses require a SAT/ACT score, pre-requisite credit, or a score on a placement exam in order to register. If you do not plan to send SAT/ACT scores and you do not have pre-requisite credit, you will need to take a placement exam before you can register for the following courses:

- Pre-Calculus (MTH 1320) or Calculus 1 (MTH 1321): <u>ALEKS Math Placement Exam</u>
- Chemistry (CHE 1301): <u>ALEKS Chemistry Exam</u>
- Foreign Language: <u>Modern Language Placement Exams</u>— this is required to register for any level of Spanish, French, or German



# Pre-Engine-Ing

All Baylor students who plan to declare an Engineering major will start in the non-degree granting "Pre-Engineering" major

- You <u>MUST</u> be Calc 1 (MTH 1321) eligible to declare Pre-Engineering and register for EGR 1301 (<u>View the Math Registration Requirements</u>)
- The <u>Pre-Engineering Progression Requirements</u> include a 'B' or higher in EGR 1301 and EGR 1302, and a 'C' or higher in your first-year math courses
- You do not need to know which Engineering Major you want to declare until you complete both EGR 1301 & 1302



# Pre-Engineering

Review the Engineering Flowcharts and start thinking about which Engineering major you plan to declare

- Electrical & Computer Engineering
- Mechanical Engineering
  - Optional Concentration: Aerospace Engineering
- Engineering with Concentration or Minor
  - Concentrations: Biomedical, Environmental, Humanitarian
  - Or choose any <u>Minor</u>



## Computer Science

Review the <u>Computer Science Flowcharts</u>

- Computer Science Major
  - 2 Optional Concentrations: Cybersecurity or Software Engineering

**Computer Science Progression Requirements** 

 Computer Science Majors must earn a B or higher in CSI 1440 (Intro to Programming II)



### Informolics

#### Review the **Bioinformatics and Data Science Flowcharts**

- All Data Science Majors are required to declare a Minor
  - Check out the <u>List of Majors and Minors</u> to start thinking about which minor you would like to declare
  - You cannot declare Computer Science, Mathematics, or Statistics as your minor, but you can pursue a secondary major in Mathematics or Statistics.
