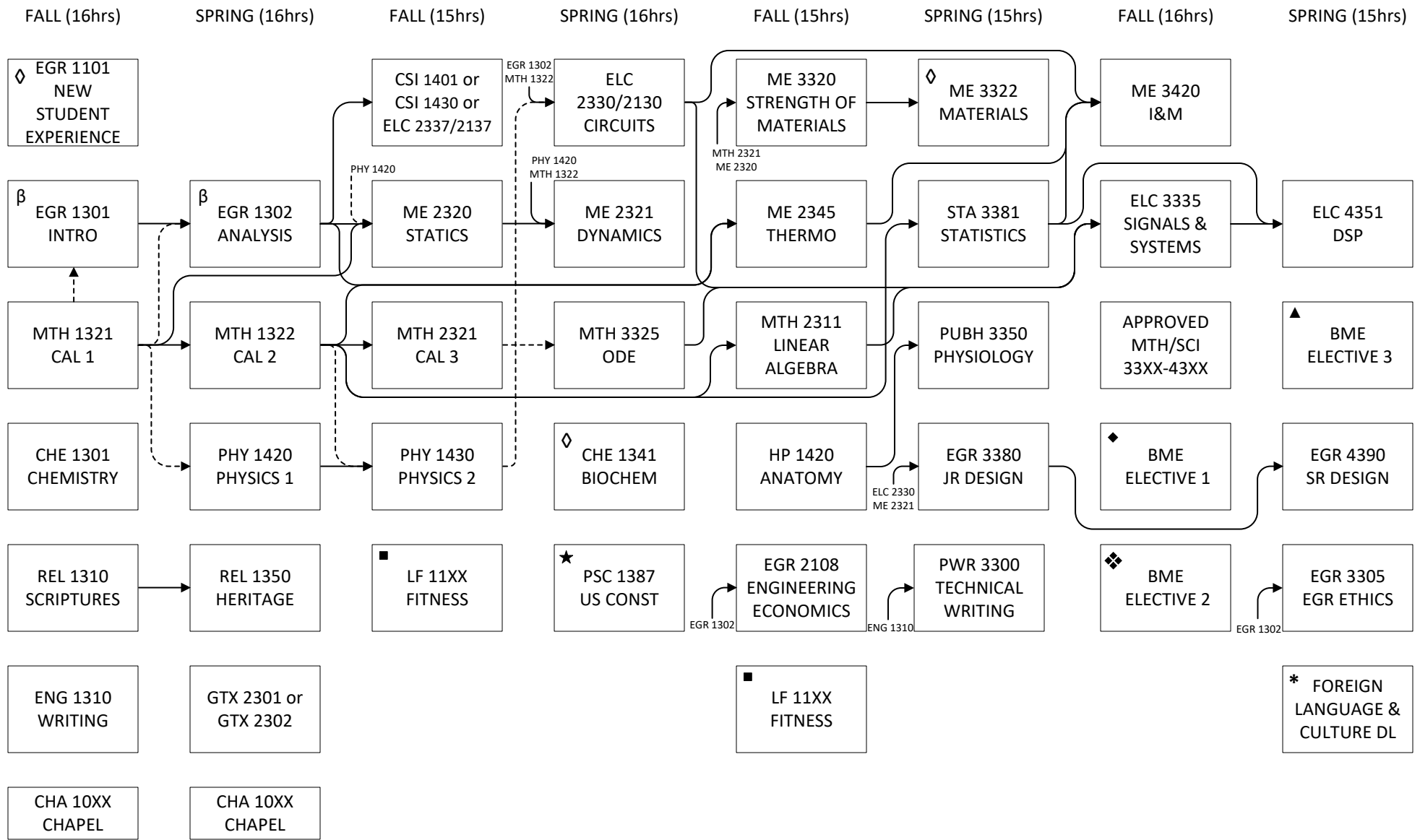


# ENGINEERING MAJOR (BIOMEDICAL CONCENTRATION) (2024-2025)
