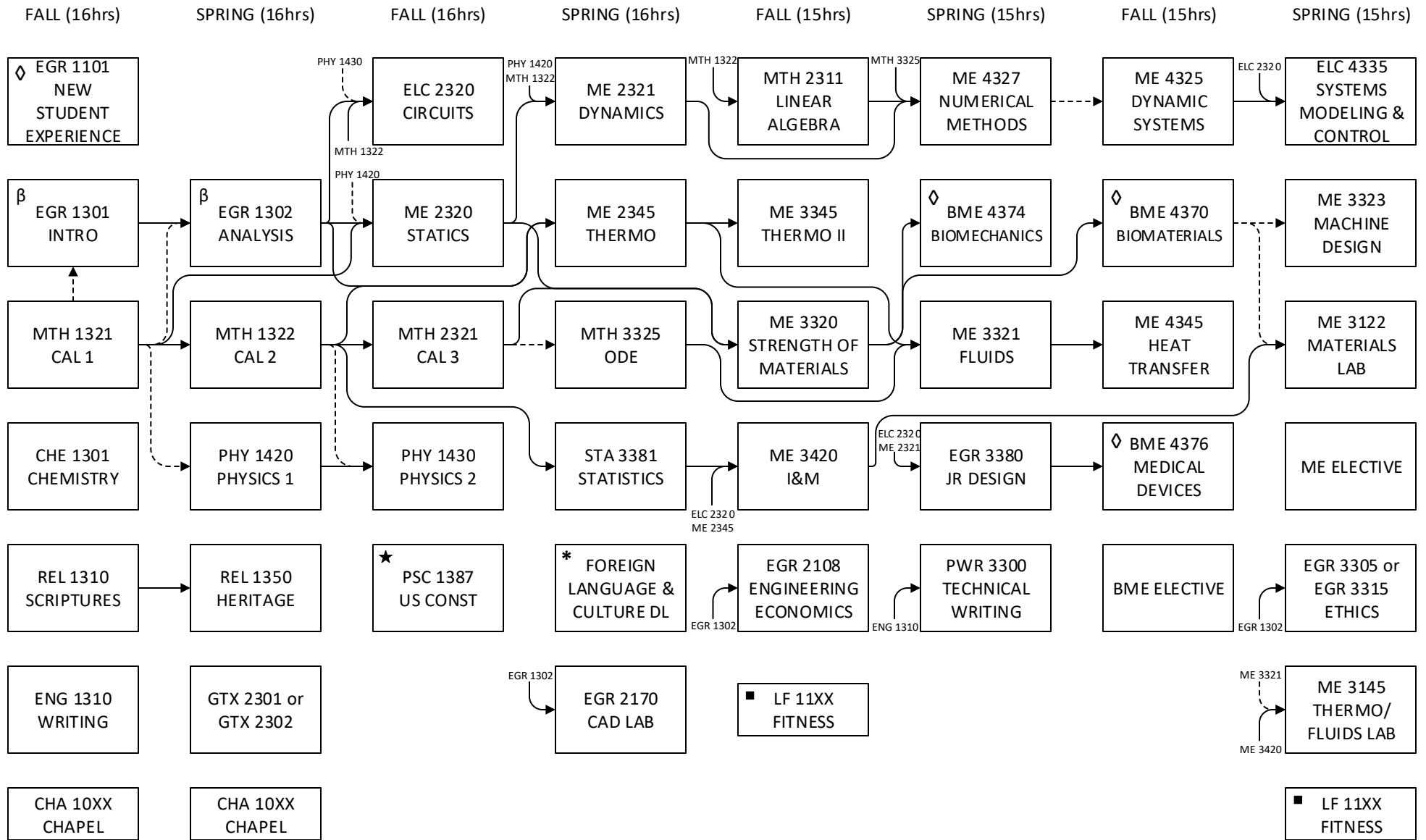


MECHANICAL ENGINEERING MAJOR (Biomechanical Concentration) (2024-2025)
