

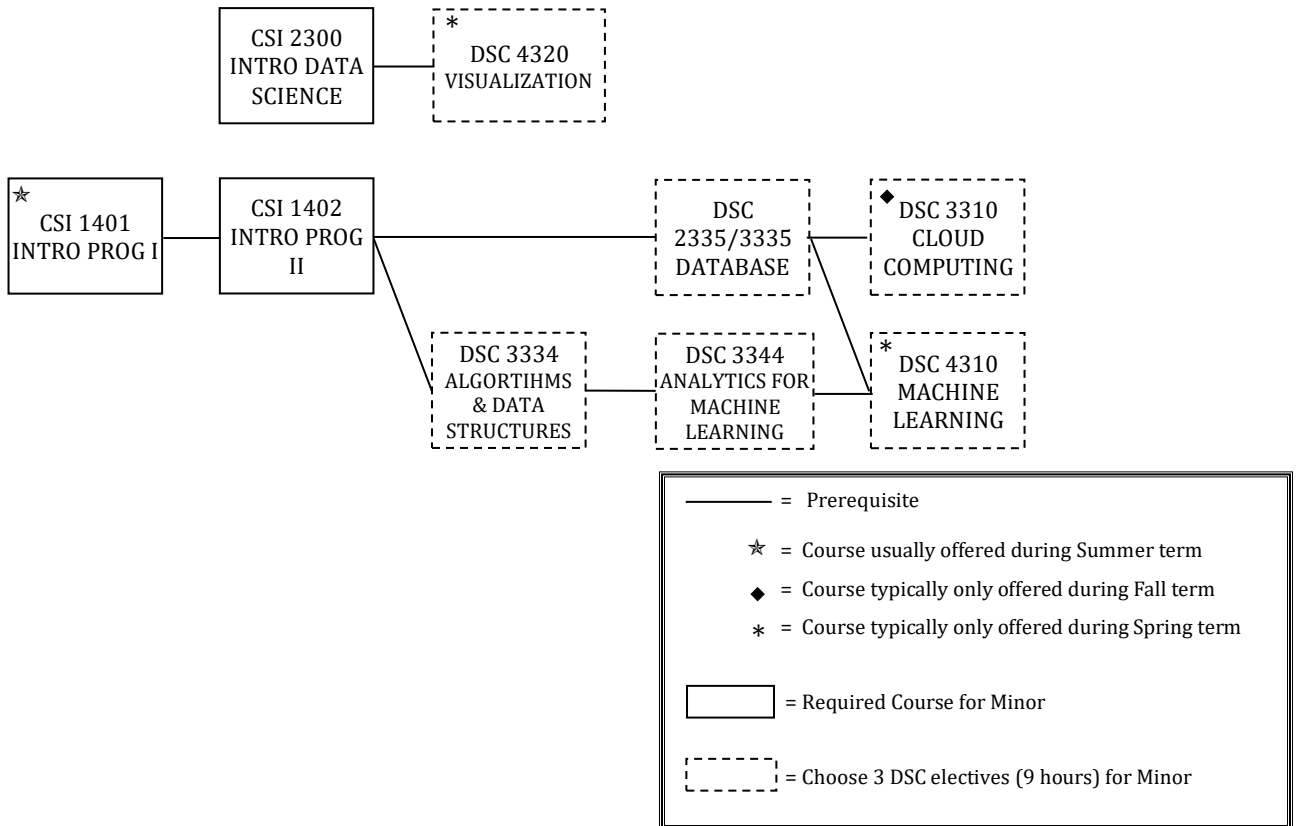
MINOR IN DATA SCIENCE

REQUIREMENTS FOR A MINOR IN DATA SCIENCE:

Twenty semester hours in computer science and data science, including the following:

- A. CSI 1401, 1402, and 2300
- B. Nine semester hours from the following 3000/4000 level courses: DSC 3310, DSC 3334, DSC 2335/3335, DSC 3344, DSC 4310, DSC 4320
- C. A grade of “C” or better in all courses used for the minor

NOTES:

- It is common among CSI/DSC courses to only have one section option per semester (or sometimes even one per year), which may create conflicts with other required classes. For this reason, we recommend reserving at least five semesters to complete the minor.
- DSC 4310 has an additional prerequisite of MTH 2311.
